At 7:22 PM the STM called under the warrant dated October 9, 2006 was reopened.

Article 1: Water & Sewer Commissioner Robert Bird moved to confirm a vote of the Special Town Meeting of November 8, 2005 to authorize the Treasurer to borrow a sum of \$200,000 to fund expenses incurred as a result of the Administrative Consent Order number ACOP-CE-05-1N008, issued by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, on July 21, 2005, to the Hopedale Wastewater Treatment Plant, and that to meet this appropriation, the Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, is authorized to borrow said amount under and pursuant to Chapter 44 of the General Laws and/or Chapter 29C of the General Laws, or pursuant to any other enabling authority and to issue bonds or notes of the Town therefore and that the Treasurer or any other official of the Town is authorized to enter into a loan agreement and/or security agreement there under and a project regulatory agreement to expend any such funds.

The motion was seconded and carried at 7:23PM.

Article 2: Selectman Michael Collins moved to raise and appropriate the sum of \$17,864 for the purpose of supplementing the Highway Departments FY07 Salaries and Wages, \$600 to supplement Highway Department Expenses, \$465 to supplement the Assessors FY07 Salary & Wages, \$1,167 to supplement the Treasurers FY07 Salaries and Wages, and from Water Department Receipts \$3,940 to supplement the Water Department FY07 Salaries and Wages, \$300 to supplement Water Department Expenses, and from Sewer Department Receipts, \$300 to supplement Sewer Department expenses voted at the Annual Town Meeting of May 2006, for the purposes of ratifying a contract commencing July 1, 2006.
