Hopedale Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes November 15, 2022

Call to Order: 6 pm by Becca Solomon Meeting held in person. A quorum was present at Town Hall.

Attendees: Becca Solomon, Dave Guglielmi, Marcia Matthews. Elenore Alves, new member.

General Business

The new member recommendation was favorable and the Commission approved unanimously and welcomed Elenore Alves as a member.

24 Hopedale Street. Request for Partial Certificate of Compliance, Irwin Engineers, DEP Files No. 187-252. Per Order of Conditions, special conditions stated January 20, 2021. Demo conditions 1-10 were released because demo activities have been done. Site visit confirmed river is clean. Ongoing maintenance and operational conditions 11-21 remain in effect.

Dave said, "We decided to focus on a performance standard and leave it to the engineers."

In the absence of the applicant, the commission approved a release of Conditions 1-10 unanimously and extended the OOC 3 years to 2027.

Site Visit

At the site visit to 24 Hopedale Street the Commission saw capped cisterns containing trichloroethylene, reportable PCE's tracked under tracking #2-16138, as well as lead, metals, PAHs (hydrocarbon) due to turbidity that stirred up sediments and interaction with chlorine. The wells are being monitored and will be tested again. A Mass. Contingency Disposal site marked by traffic cones, a fence and a garage, remains on the periphery near the Mill River.

Committee Business

Becca requested members attend the Community Preservation Act committee. Funds will be used to preserve the natural character and culture of the town.

There were no minutes of October, 2022 because the meeting was canceled.
