



TOWN OF HOPEDALE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION DAY

The Town of HOPEDALE will conduct a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day on **Saturday, November 5, 2016**. HOPEDALE residents only, may bring allowed materials to the town Recycling Center on Thwing Street between the hours of 9 a.m. and 1 p.m.

Materials which will be permitted at the drop-off are as follows:

Oils (spent motor oil), gasoline, gasoline mixtures, auto batteries, pesticides, thinners, spent antifreeze, oil-based paints and stains, photo chemicals, pool chemicals, household chemicals (drain cleaners, cleaners, detergents, etc.) and aerosols. Fluorescent light bulbs and compact fluorescent light bulbs can be brought to at any time throughout the year. Latex paint or stain cans may be opened to the air to dry and disposed of with your weekly trash.

Materials which will **NOT** be permitted at the drop-off are as follows:

Compressed gas cylinders (propane, oxygen, etc.), smoke detectors, fireworks, ammunition, tires, asbestos, white goods (refrigerators, etc.), pesticides containing Pentachlorophenol and/or 2, 4, 5-T/Silvex, PCB (capacitors, transformers, light ballasts).

No commercial vehicles or commercial wastes will be allowed
