Saturdays 9:00 a.m. to 1 p.m.*

PERMITS ARE REQUIRED

Residents of the Town of Hopedale may use the recycling center provided they **purchase a permit** from the **Board of Health Office** or from the attendant at the **Recycling Center**.

No dump trucks or commercial vehicles are allowed. Owners of rental property who do not reside at the property will not be allowed. No commercial or industrial businesses are allowed to use this facility.

Items allowed include:

- Grass clippings, leaves and brush
- The following items must be cut up and/or dismantled;
Oil tanks, heaters, metal items such as washing machines, dryers, air conditioners, propane tanks, swing sets, television sets and stereos

Items *not* allowed include:

- No household garbage or rubbish
- Large auto parts such as car bodies, boat parts
- Toxic waste including pathological waste or animal carcasses
- Rocks, boulders, cement, asphalt or bricks
- Plaster wallboard
- Tree stumps

**EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2014 ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BY CHECK ONLY
AND MADE PAYABLE TO THE TOWN OF HOPEDALE**

Utility Trailer, max 6’ X 6’ X 3’ vans	\$23.00
Station Wagon, 6’ bed pickup truck or van	\$12.00
One half load of a truck, trailer, van	\$12.00
One half load or less of station wagon	\$6.00
Car with trunk half full or less	\$3.00
Bath tubs (metal only)	\$25.00
Plumbing fixtures (no porcelain or fiberglass)	\$10.00
Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers, white goods	\$20.00
Propane tanks / microwave ovens	\$15.00
Other small appliances (such as a mixer)	\$7.00
Computers	\$15.00
Television – 36” or less	\$20.00
Television – over 36”	\$30.00
Bicycles	\$5.00
Ride-on mowers	\$18.00
Push mowers	\$10.00
Exercise Equipment (per piece)	\$10.00
Grills (without tank)	\$7.00
Weed Whackers	\$4.00
Metal fencing	Per Attendant
Recording Devices (such as VCR, DVD, CD and Blu Ray Players)	\$7.00
Used Motor Oil	FREE
