## **Consent Items**

<u>Minutes of the September 13<sup>th</sup> meeting</u> – Commissioner Morin made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 13<sup>th</sup> meeting and made unanimous by Chairperson Burke.

## **Appointments - None**

#### **New Business**

- A. November Town Meeting warrant is currently open and will be closing next week. Tim does not foresee having anything on this warrant. We will have to come up with money regarding unforeseen insurance bonuses but Tim feels this can be taken out of Retained Earnings.
- B. Well Cleaning Results bedrock well #2 was cleaned. At the end of November or December, during the slow times, we will have the other 3 wells cleaned.
- C. Fall Hydrant Flushing hydrant flushing will begin the evening of Sunday, October 14<sup>th</sup> and will take between a week and a half to two weeks.

## **Old Business**

- A. <u>WWTP update</u> There have been no change orders as of yet and completion should be by November 15<sup>th</sup>. Due to all the rain Tim feels they may not meet that date. Tim feels there may be 1 change order for between \$10,000 and 20,000.
- B. New Service Request South Main Street Sewer the Board had previously approved the connection off of South Main Street. Tim did speak with John Mainini from Milford Sewer and he stated he has not heard back from his town counsel yet. Tim feels we should send Mr. Mainini and his Board a letter.
- C. <u>Plant Alarms Update</u> all are up and running great. Tim feels this was money well spent.

Manager's Report – Tim informed the Board that the sewer employee that fell on the rocks last month is back to work on light duty.
