Magazines are now available through C/WMARS Over-Drive! Our first wave of 50 magazines is available in the CW MARS OverDrive catalog – later this year the collection will grow to 100 magazines. You can access them either through Libby or the OverDrive app. They can be read online or downloaded for offline reading. Check out is for 7, 14, or 21 days. The magazines are all purchased under a "simultaneous use" agreement. This means every magazine is always available. There's no waiting. If someone wants to read a magazine, they can. All you need is a library card and access to the internet.

# Boston Public Library eCard – free to everyone in MA Did you know you can use the Boston Public Library online resources? All residents of Massachusetts may use the online resources of the Boston Public Library – just sign up for a free eCard at www.bpl.org.\_You will have access to Hoopla Streaming Media (TV shows, movies), RBDigital magazines as well as newspapers, electronic journals, magazine articles, and specialized data. Once you have your BPL eCard, you will need to create an account with Hoopla and RBDigital.

<u>Hoopla Streaming Media</u> provides access to movies, TV shows, music, audiobooks, eBooks, and comics for online streaming or download to mobile devices, with no waiting lists. Borrow up to 10 items per calendar month. Many of the BBC series

RBDigital magazines provides access to full-color popular magazines in English, Spanish, Chinese, and Vietnamese, available for online reading or download to mobile devices with no waiting lists, no checkout periods, and no limits.

The book group does not meet in July or


August. Book discussions will resume Wednesday,
