## Holiday Hours


The Library will be closed **Monday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>**, in observance of Labor Day. Enjoy your holiday!

Deserted by her lover, Sunja is saved when a young tubercular minister offers to marry and bring her to Japan. So begins a sweeping saga of an exceptional family in exile from its homeland and caught in the indifferent arc of history. Through desperate struggles and hard-won triumphs, its members are bound together by deep roots as they face enduring questions of faith, family, and identity"*-- adapted from C/WMARS catalog

Cherie & Dave have ways of teaching juggling so that even the biggest klutz will understand how to juggle by the end of the class and, of course, it is taught in a




