Bancroft Memorial Library is celebrating the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the building's dedication with a display of historical



photos and artifacts. Dedicated on December 14, 1899, BML was a gift from Joseph Bancroft and the family to honor matriarch Sylvia Thwing Bancroft, who died in 1898. According to the couple's daughter Lilla, Sylvia was a devoted reader. "It was her joy in books that after her death suggested the idea to Father of a Memorial Library," Lilla wrote.
