WiFi HotSpots - Enjoy high-speed Internet



access anytime, anywhere-free!

We have recently acquired 2 WiFi HotSpots to loan to our patrons.

What is a HotSpot? The HotSpot is an easy -to-use mobile device that offers Internet access over the Sprint network using WiFi technology. You can connect up to 10 Wi-Fi enabled devices to a BML HotSpot and get high-speed Internet virtually anywhere you can get Sprint mobile service. Our 2 HotSpots can be checked out for a week at a time and Bancroft Memorial Library patrons in good standing can place holds on them.
