OverDrive Electronic collection Have you tried Overdrive yet? 2018 was the first year our OverDrive collection had over **one million checkouts**! OverDrive is a free service that lets you borrow digital content anytime, anywhere. The collection includes over 70,000 ebooks and audiobooks. To get started, download the Libby app for OverDrive from the Google Playstore, the Apple store and for Windows 10+. A HotSpot is an easy -to-use mobile device that offers Internet access over the Sprint network using WiFi technology. You can connect up to 10 Wi-Fi enabled devices to a BML HotSpot and get high-speed Internet virtually anywhere you can get Sprint mobile service. Our 2 HotSpots can be checked out for a week at a time and Bancroft Memorial Library patrons in good standing can place holds on them.
