After a brief discussion, it was moved by Mr. MacDonald, seconded by Mr. Swift, to not allow non-residents to drop off leaves, grass, brush, construction or demolition items; and, further, to set the fee for items #9

through #23 at five dollars more than Hopedale residents; to set the fee for item #24 at \$10.00; and set the fee for item #25 at \$2.00. All voted in favor.
