### Board of Health Meeting Regular Meeting Minutes August 15, 2019

Upon submission of a sewage disposal system plan, the Health Agent will review and approve the plan. Once approved by the Health Agent, the Board of Health Office will contact the property owner and engineer to advise that the project may begin and that the plans will then be brought forward at the next Board of Health meeting for official approval by the Board. Once official approval has been given by the Board, a permit will be issued from the Board of Health Office. However, if a request for a variance to any section of 310 CMR 15 Title V Standard Requirements is made, then the Board of Health Office will NOT take any action until the Board has approved the plan with the variance. Once the Board has approved the plan, the Board of Health Office will then contact the property owner and engineer and issue the permit.

All voted in favor.

2. Approval of Sewage Disposal Plan: 4 Condon Way (Lot #15)

After a brief discussion, it was moved by Mr. Howes, seconded by Mr. MacDonald, to approve the sewage disposal plan for 4 Condon Way (Lot #15). All voted in favor.

3. Approval of Sewage Disposal Plan: 6 Condon Way (Lot #14)

After a brief discussion, it was moved by Mr. Howes, seconded by Mr. MacDonald, to approve the sewage disposal plan for 6 Condon Way (Lot #14). All voted in favor.
