MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR (May be on hold due to COVID-19)

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. **The repair must be deemed a safety concern** in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone



numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with **free** house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.

Please schedule your van ride 3 (three) business days in advance of your requested ride. Our new schedule (hours of operation) for local errand transportation is as follows:

Monday 9:00 am to 2:00 pm Tuesday 9:00 am to 2:00 pm Thursday 9:00 am to 2:00 pm

Friday 9:30 am to 12:00 pm (per availability of driver)

Please remember that due to COVID-19 restrictions we can only have two (2) passengers in the van at the same time. All riders are temperature screened and required to cover their nose and mouth with a face mask.
