Tax Credit Program Applications Available at the Hopedale Senior Center



Applications are available for the Sr.

Citizen Real Estate Tax Credit Program. This highly successful program is open to seniors age sixty (60) and older who reside in their Hopedale homes and pay real estate taxes to the town of Hopedale.

Qualified program participants work in various town departments. In lieu of pay, seniors who complete the required 84 hours of service, receive a \$1000.00 real estate tax credit (minus required taxes and withholdings). Participants receive the tax credit in the following fiscal year. Please note that there are a limited number of positions and only one application per household. The Tax Credit Policy can be found online on the Town's Webpage under the Council on Aging's tab. Applications are available at the Hopedale Senior Center. The application deadline is December 19, 2022.


