MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR (May be on hold due to COVID-19)

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. **The repair must be deemed a safety concern** in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact num-



bers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with **free** house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.

COPY/FAX SERVICES - We will make copies for you or Fax documents. 10 cents per page (Call for an appointment).

NEWS FROM SHINE FOR JULY 2020 THE SHINE PROGRAM IS OPEN AND AVAILABLE

We want to let everyone know that although our senior center partners are operating on a limited basis due to the COVID emergency, the SHINE Program is continu-



ing to operate. Although we cannot provide office appointments at this time, our counselors are still available to assist you to answer any of your Medicare related questions. You can reach us if: you are aging into Medicare at 65, you have lost your employment coverage for any reason and you are 65 or older, or simply have a general question about your current Medicare coverage. Our counselors who are working remotely will return your call within 1 business day. If you live in Central Mass call us at 508-422-9931. We are also available via Zoom video conferencing to do one-on-one appointments if needed. In the near future we will be doing Medicare 101 presentations via Zoom. Are You Suffering from Mask Fatigue?

As the weeks turn into months many folks are resigned to the new measures we must practice regarding the wearing of face masks. However, there seems to be a growing laxity about the proper way to wear a masks inside markets and stores.

Simply stated, a mask must cover both your nose and mouth. If you have medical considerations, please consult your physician for appropriate measures you can safely take so you may gain admittance into stores in Massachusetts. *The Lancet*, a prestigious medical journal wrote in a June 1, 2020 article that mask wearing significantly reduces the risk of viral transmission.

- Appointments between 9:00 am 2:30 pm Monday Friday
- No transit between 11:30 noon and 1:00 pm daily
- \$2.00 one way / \$3.00 round trip
- Handicapped Accessible Van Curb to Curb service only.
- COVID-19 precautions require a brief medical query.
- All riders must wear a mask

REAL ID's

On March 23rd, the federal government announced a revised REAL ID compliance deadline of October 1, 2021. During the State of Emergency, the RMV has suspended the issuance of new REAL IDs unless it is part of a first time issuance, out of state conversion, or other limited circumstance. Customers who renew for a 'standard' Massachusetts driver's license or ID card online between June 12 and August 12, 2020, will be able to upgrade to a REAL ID if they need it in 2021 at no additional charge. The cost of a license or ID renewal is \$50 for a standard' or REAL ID, while the amendment or upgrade fee waived by an Executive Order is \$25.
