



OUTREACH SERVICES

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

Confidential counseling with our Veterans' Agent, Pat Morris. Individuals issues or medical conditions do not have to be "service-related".

MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. The repair must be *deemed a safety concern* in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with free house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.



<u>NEWS FROM SHINE APRIL 2019</u> THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVELS HAVE INCREASED

As a result of increases to the Federal Poverty Level, Eligibility Guidelines for Public Benefits Programs in Massachusetts have changed. MassHealth has increased the income limits for several programs you may be eligible for. The income to be eligible for MassHealth **Standard** has increased from \$1,012 for a single person to \$1,041, for a married couple it has gone up to from \$1,372 to \$1,410.

For another popular program MassHealth **Buy-in (this would pay your Medicare Part B Premium)** the eligibility income has gone up from \$1,366 to \$1,406 for a single person, and from \$1,852 to \$1,903 for a couple. These increases also apply to **Full Extra Help** a program from Social Security that helps pay for your medications. You can qualify for **Partial Extra Help** if your income is below \$1,561 for a single person and \$2,114 for a married couple. If you feel you may be eligible under these new income guidelines feel free to call the SHINE Program for more information.

"SHINE'S MEDICARE AND MORE" PROGRAM

The Central MASS SHINE Program is now sponsoring a monthly Cable TV program called SHINE's MEDICARE AND MORE", we hope your local cable channel will pick it up. This program is designed to educate and update MEDICARE beneficiaries and their families on MEDICARE and other programs that can assist you with your health insurance needs. If you don't see it on your local cable channel give them call and ask about it.

We are happy to announce we have recently upgraded our SHINE website <u>www.shinema.org</u>, this upgrade is more user friendly and provides easier access and viewing to more digital devices such as cell phones and tablets. It is a great source for Medicare, MassHealth and SHINE information and is available to consumers all over the state.

Trained SHINE (Serving Health Information Needs of Everyone) volunteers can help you! . Call your senior center and ask for a SHINE appointment. You can also call 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say 3. Once you get the SHINE answering machine, leave your name and number. A volunteer will call you back. <u>www.shinema.org</u>.
