

Seniors and disabled adults who need transportation may use our new van to come to the Sr. Center, go grocery shopping, personal shopping or get to the bank, hair

salon, barber or other local non-medical destinations. The new Sr. Center van is available on :

Thursday	9:00 am - 1:00 pm

The cost for most roundtrip rides is \$3.00.

Individuals who want to use the van must register by calling the Sr. Center at (508)634-2208. Van service picks you up at your home and transports you to your requested destination.

Please remember that we have a separate van service for medical appointments and prescription pick-ups. Call the Sr. Center directly at (508)634-2208 for rides to your medical appointments. Let us help you with any questions you may have. We can register you in the comfort of your home.

OUTREACH SERVICES

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

Confidential counseling with our Veterans' Agent, Pat Morris. Individuals issues or medical conditions do not have to be "service-related".

MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. *The repair must be deemed a safety concern* in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with **free** house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.

Bellingham-Hopedale Housing Rehabilitation Program

THE GRANDPARENTS SCAM


In a typical Grandparent Scam, a con artist calls or emails the victim posing as a relative in distress or someone claiming to represent the relative (such as a lawyer or law enforcement agent). The "relative" of the grandparent explains she is in trouble and needs their grandparent to wire them funds that will be used for bail money, lawyer's fees, hospital bills, or another fictitious expense.

The victim is urged not to tell anyone, such as the parent of the "grandchild" because they do not want them to find out about the trouble they've gotten themselves into. The grandparent never hears from their fake grandchild again and is tricked out of hundreds or even thousands of dollars.

To detect and avoid the Grandparent Scam, NCL's Fraud Center recommends the following tips:

Before sending funds, independently contact the relative (or parent of the relative) the scam artist is claiming to be (or represent) at a known phone number to verify the details of the story.

Scam artist's payment methods of choice are the wire transfer or gift cards. Any urgent request to wire money or purchase gift cards should be treated suspiciously. Be aware that fraudsters attempting the Grandparent Scam may call late at night to confuse potential victims. Consumers who have been victims of this scam should immediately report it to local law enforcement, their state attorney general and NCL's Fraud Center at Fraud.org.
