#### **OUTREACH SERVICES**

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

### VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

Confidential counseling with our Veterans' Agent, Pat Morris. Individuals issues or medical conditions do not have to be "service-related".

### MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicard. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

#### HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. *The repair must be deemed a safety concern* in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

#### FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

#### **HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE**

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with **free** house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.

### **Bellingham-Hopedale Housing Rehabilitation Program**







### NEWS FROM SHINE JUNE 2018 NEW MEDICARE CARDS ARE COMING

We want everyone to remember you will be getting a new Medicare Card between now and April 2019, Medicare will be removing Social Security numbers from Medicare cards and mailing each person a new card. This will help keep your information more secure and help protect your identity. You'll get a new randomly selected Medicare Number that's unique to you, and it will only be used for your Medicare coverage. The new card won't change your coverage or benefits. You'll get more information when your new card is mailed. A couple of things to point out—If you change your address be sure to notify Social Security promptly so your new card can be mailed to the correct address. Also, beware of anyone who contacts you about your new Medicare card, Medicare will not ask you to give them personal or private information to get your new Medicare Number and card. We will keep you posted on the mailing schedule, as of now Massachusetts beneficiaries will get their new cards sometime after June 2018.

### "SHINE'S MEDICARE AND MORE" PROGRAM

The Central MASS SHINE Program is now sponsoring a monthly Cable TV program called SHINE's MEDICARE AND MORE", we hope your local cable channel will pick it up. This program is designed to educate and update MEDICARE beneficiaries and their families on MEDICARE and other programs that can assist you with your health insurance needs. If you don't see it on your local cable channel give them call and ask about it.
