

OUTREACH SERVICES

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

Confidential counseling with our Veterans' Agent, Pat Morris. Individuals issues or medical conditions do not have to be "service-related".

MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. *The repair must be deemed a safety concern* in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with **free** house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.



NEWS FROM SHINE JUNE 2019

MASSACHUSETTS VETERANS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR MEDICAL EXPENSES

Chapter 115 of the Massachusetts General Laws entitles eligible Massachusetts veterans and their spouses, or in some cases widows / widowers, to reimbursement of medical expenses if they meet certain income and asset guidelines.

Income	
Number in Family	Maximum Monthly Income
1	\$2081.00
2 (+)	\$2817.00

Assets

Single	\$5,000.00
Married	\$9,800.00

This program is an entitlement in recognition of your service and not charity. You may reimbursed for your Medicare Premium and all your other health insurance expenses. If you meet these guidelines, <u>contact your local city or town Veteran's Service Officer and tell them you would like to submit a</u> <u>Chapter 115 application for benefits. The only requirement is the income guidelines above and a</u> <u>copy of the veterans discharge DD214 indicating active service. If you have any questions regarding these benefits call our Regional Office at 508-422-9931.</u> <u>IMPORTANT INFORMATION</u>

Always remember that if you are turning 65 you should contact Social Security to enroll in Medicare. Medicare eligibility has no connection to your eligibility for Social Security benefits. Also, coverage from the Health Connector does not exempt you from this requirement to enroll in Medicare, as you will lose your Health Connector subsidy when you turn 65. 

Dear Friends,

We are being "scammed to death"! Older people especially are being targeted. As a group, you are kind and willing to give others the benefit of the doubt. These traits are being exploited and the results can be devastating.

Please be aware:

- The IRS will not call you on the phone!
- Do not give anyone your bank account or Social Security numbers over the phone.
- It is OK to just hang-up the phone.
- Get a Caller ID phone so you don't have to talk to random callers.
- If someone calls claiming to be your grandchild and is requesting that you wire money because he/she is in trouble and is afraid to call his/her parents, hang-up and call their parents immediately. Do not wire any money. This is a well documented scam.
