

OUTREACH SERVICES

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

Confidential counseling with our Veterans' Agent, Pat Morris. Individuals issues or medical conditions do not have to be "service-related".

MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. The repair must be deemed a safety concern in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with free house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.

Bellingham-Hopedale Housing Rehabilitation Program

Leaking roofs, failing heating systems, etc. requiring immediate emergency assistance may be eligible for this grant. Call the Sr. Center for eligibility requirements and more information.

NEWS FROM SHINE FOR MAY 2019

Need Help with the Cost of your Prescription Medications?? Prescription Advantage can Help!!

Prescription Advantage is a state-run program which helps many seniors pay for their prescription drugs. Eligibility is based on *income only* and there is *no asset limit*!

Who can join?

If you are a Massachusetts resident, eligible for Medicare, and are:

65 years or older with an annual income at or less than \$62,450 for a single person or \$84,550 for a married couple

OR

Under 65 years and disabled, with an annual income at or less than \$23,481 for a single person or \$31,791 for a married couple.

You may also join... if you are 65 years or older and **not eligible for Medicare. There** is *no income limit*.


There is **no charge** for joining Prescription Advantage, if you have an annual income at or less than \$37,470 for a single person and \$50,730 for a married couple. There is a \$200 per person annual enrollment fee for those with higher incomes.

Call Prescription Advantage today to enroll on the phone or ask for an application form. You can reach Prescription Advantage at 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say **2**. You may also apply on line by going to **www.prescriptionadvantagema.org.**

Trained SHINE (Serving Health Information Needs of Everyone) volunteers can help you! They offer free, unbiased, confidential counseling on all aspects of health insurance to anyone on Medicare. Call your senior center and ask for a SHINE appointment. You can also call 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say 3. Once you get the SHINE voice mail, leave your name and number.
