The Fuel Assistance application period has been extended through 5/31/2020. You may qualify for reimbursements for fuel bills that you have already paid.





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## NEWS FROM SHINE MAY 2020

Are you 65 or older, or eligible for Medicare because of disability? Are you losing your health care coverage from your employer?

If you delayed taking Medicare Part B because you were covered by an employer but may be losing coverage because of layoff or retirement, contact the SHINE Program.



SHINE (Serving the Health Insurance Needs of Everyone) can answer your questions. You have a window of opportunity to sign up for Medicare Part B if you are losing employer-based coverage. SHINE counselors can explain the process and the forms that need to be submitted to Social Security. They can also review what your medical and prescription coverage options are beyond Medicare Part A and Part B.

You may call the Hopedale Sr. Center at (508)634-2208 and request a SHINE appointment.

Trained SHINE (Serving Health Information Needs of Everyone) volunteers can help you! They offer free, unbiased, confidential counseling on all aspects of health insurance to anyone on Medicare. <u>During the current Stay at Home order our staff and counselors are responding to calls remotely. ### Heating Assistance is available for Homeowners and Renters.

Electric, Oil, Gas, Wood, Propane, Kerosene and Coal

The application period has been extended until May 31, 2020.

Income eligibility guidelines: Maximum gross income:

1 person: \$37,360 2 people: \$48,855

SMOC provides assistance through a fixed benefit amount for the cost of your primary source of heat which includes, but is not limited to: oil, electricity, natural gas, propane, kerosene, wood, or coal. If eligible, discounts may be automatically given on: electric bills, gas bills and telephones bills. Weatherization services may also be available to qualified applicants (furnace, window and appliance replacement). Applications are available through the Sr. Center.
