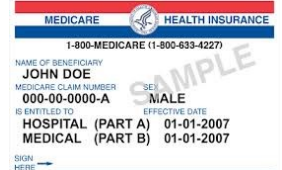

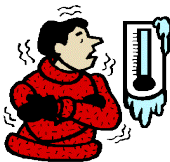

OUTREACH SERVICES

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

Confidential counseling with our Veterans' Agent. Individuals issues or medical conditions do not have to be "service-related".

MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING

SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. *The repair must be deemed a safety concern* in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.

HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS PROGRAM - FREE

A wooden number sign is available to all Hopedale residents. As a public safety measure, all residences are required to display house numbers. The TRIAD program will provide you with **free** house number sign. Please contact us for more information on how to obtain a free house number sign.

NEED A WAY TO PAY FOR HOME REPAIRS? HAVE AN EMERGENCY REPAIR OR A REPAIR THAT'S A SAFETY ISSUE? HOME REPAIR LOAN PROGRAM

Bellingham-Hopedale Housing Rehabilitation Program

Leaking roofs, failing heating systems, etc. requiring immediate emergency assistance may be eligible for this grant. Call the Sr. Center for eligibility requirements and more information.

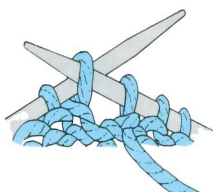

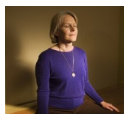

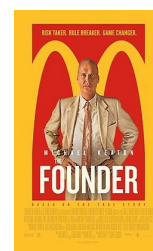

NEWS FROM SHINE OCTOBER & NOVEMBER 2017

**The Medicare Open Enrollment begins on October 15th
and ends on December 7th**

Don't Wait Until It's Too Late!

Open Enrollment Appointments will begin in mid October.

Every year, Medicare Part D and Medicare Advantage (HMO, PPO) plans can change their premiums, co-pays, deductibles, formularies (list of drugs covered) and preferred pharmacies. In the case of Medicare Advantage Plans they can also drop providers from their Plan. It's important to review your options EVERY year to make sure you have the plan that works best for you for next year. This year we are anticipating that there may be some new plans and choices for you to make. Along with these new plans and choices we expect there will be some aggressive marketing with an unusual high volume of plan sponsored meetings. **REMEMBER!! YOU NEED TO BE SURE THAT YOUR PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN AND OTHER PROVIDERS ARE COVERED IN THE PLANS NETWORK BEFORE YOU CHANGE TO A DIFFERENT MEDICARE PLAN. YOU SHOULD ALSO BE SURE YOUR MEDICATIONS ARE COVERED AS WELL.**

Assistance is available from the SHINE program. Call your Senior Center and ask for a SHINE appointment. Trained SHINE volunteers offer free, confidential counseling on all aspects of health insurance to anyone on Medicare.

MEDICARE UPDATE MEETINGS

We have scheduled 25 Medicare Update Meetings in the Central Massachusetts area. Check with your local Senior Center to find a meeting near your home. Or check our website www.shinema.org for a list of our local meetings.

Trained SHINE (Serving Health Information Needs of Everyone) volunteers can help you! They offer free, unbiased, confidential counseling on all aspects of health insurance to anyone on Medicare. Call your senior center and ask for a SHINE appointment. You can also call 1-800-AGE-INFO (1-800-243-4636), then press or say 3. Once you get the SHINE answering machine, leave your name and number. A volunteer will call you back. During Open Enrollment it may take a couple of days to return your call. You can now visit us on the internet at shinema.org
