

Effective November 1, 2019,



applications are available for the 2020 Sr. Citizens' Real Estate Tax Credit Program. The program is open to seniors age sixty (60) and older who reside in their Hopedale homes and pay real estate taxes to the town of Hopedale. Qualified program participants work in various town departments. In lieu of pay, seniors who complete the required 84 hours of service will receive a \$1000.00 real estate tax credit (minus required taxes and withholdings). OUTREACH SERVICES

Confidential counseling, caregiver support, information and referral services are available on aging issues for seniors and caregivers.

VETERANS' SERVICES FOR VETERANS AND SPOUSES OF VETERANS

MEDICARE, MEDICAID AND HEALTH AND DRUG INSURANCE COUNSELING SHINE PROGRAM

Information and assistance is available on all aspects of Medicare coverage and assistance plans available through Medicare & Medicaid. Supplemental health and drug insurance coverage information and assistance for Medicare eligible individuals.

HOME REPAIR

Any senior age sixty (60) and older, who owns and resides in their home, can apply for home repair assistance. The repair must be deemed a safety concern in order to qualify for this service. There is no income guideline for this program.

FILE OF LIFE PROGRAM - FREE

The Sr. Center will provide you with a magnetic card that can be placed on your refrigerator or carried in your purse. The pre-printed card has space for emergency contact numbers, your current medications as well as you attending physicians' names and phone numbers. In the event of an emergency if you are unable to communicate, the card may provide information critical to your care.



<u>NEWS FROM SHINE NOVEMBER 2019</u> Medicare Open Enrollment ends on December 7th.

Every year, Medicare Part D and Medicare Advantage (HMO, PPO) plans can change their premiums, co-pays, deductibles, formularies (list of drugs covered) and preferred pharmacies. In the case of Medicare Advantage Plans they can also drop providers from their Plan. It's important to review your options EVERY year to make sure you have the plan that works best for you for next year. This year we are anticipating that there may be some new plans and choices for you to make. Along with these new plans and choices we expect there will be some aggressive marketing with an unusual high volume of plan sponsored meetings.

REMEMBER!! YOU NEED TO BE SURE THAT YOUR PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN AND OTHER PROVIDERS ARE COVERED IN THE PLANS NETWORK **BEFORE** YOU CHANGE TO A DIFFERENT MEDICARE PLAN. YOU SHOULD ALSO BE SURE YOUR MEDICATIONS ARE COVERED AS WELL.

ADDITIONALLY STARTING THIS YEAR, WE ARE STRONGLY URGING ALL BENEFI-CIARIES, TO SIGN UP FOR A "MyMedicare Account". HAVING THIS ACCOUNT WILL ALLOW US TO ASSIST YOU MORE COMPREHENSIVELY WITH YOU CHOICES FOR 2020. INFORMATION ON SIGNING UP IS AVAILABLE ON OUR WEBSITE www.shinema.org. Once you get the SHINE answering machine, leave your name and number. A volunteer will call you back. During Open Enrollment it may take a couple of days to return your call.
