There will be a limit of 55, with six people per table. Police and fire department members will help serve. If the covid situation worsens, it could be turned into a grab and go meal.

Veterans' Day observance – Dave complimented Carole for her leadership in putting the Veterans' Day event together. He also mentioned that he'd heard a lot of positive community feedback on it.
