February 3, 2021 Meeting Minutes 6:00 pm, via Zoom

Attendees:

Finance Committee Present: E. Callahan, C. Hodgens, D. Madigan, P. Maloney, Absent: D. Comastra, D. Piatt, C. Strapponi

The Finance Committee meeting was opened at 6:04pm by Chris Hodgens.

Votes:

Meeting minutes for January 21, 2021 were presented. A typographical error regarding the date of the next meeting was noted. A motion was made to accept the minutes; all voted in favor.

Events:

- 1. The committee reviewed various elements to consider in the development of the upcoming budget:
 - *a.* The Massachusetts Municipal Association (MMA) and Governor Baker's administration put forth a proposed increase of 3.5% Unrestricted General Government Aid (UGGA).
 - *b.* All department heads have turned in initial preliminary budgets and commentary.
 - c. Patrick Maloney is setting up a meeting with Blackstone Valley Tech.
- 2. The committee discussed emails and reports forwarded from Diana Schindler, Town Administrator:
 - *a*. Clarification on the FY21 debt schedule is necessary; a memo from the Town Administrator indicates an incorrect figure may have been used in forecasting FY21.
 - *b.* Anticipated revenue from cannabis operations needs to be reflected and clearly marked in the budget documents.

Finance Committee

- *c*. Account titles in the budget documents need to be clarified (ex.: Beeper in the Water & Sewer Department is actually for call-back pay, not a physical pager device)
- *d.* Email accounts for elected and appointed officials are to be established and costs reflected in the budget
- e. An update on the trash collection fees and potential changes is necessary
- 3. The Finance Committee will cluster together smaller departments for budget discussion and reserve larger blocks of time for larger departments. Potential dates:
 - *a*. February 10, 2021 7:00pm
 - b. February 17, 2021 7:00pm
 - c. February 27, 2021 potential long Saturday session
- 4. The Chair made reference to a potential settlement agreement regarding the purchase of land discussed in previous meetings. Information will be forwarded at a future time.

The Finance Committee Chair called the meeting to Adjournment at 6:55 pm.
