Park Commission

Parks Commission Meeting Minutes 21 May, 2015

The regular Meeting of the Board and Selectmen was called to order at 19:04 by Chair Dan Iacovelli in the Draper Room of Town Hall.

Present: Dan Iacovelli, Rob Jackson, Don Howes, Dave Guglielmi, Mike Smith

Logistics:

- Enact sign-in sheets for future meetings to record citizen attendance

Action->> Don Howes to obtain official sign-in sheets

- Provide 8-10 copies of agenda at future meetings
- Discussion over past minutes from 14 May, Need to review/approve at the next official meeting in June

Chair Iacovelli moved to Agenda Items

Reorganization of seats

- Dan Iacovelli renominated as Chair
- Treasurer Rob Jackson Nominated
- Secretary Rob Jackson Nominated
- MSDV to approve all nominated positions unanimous aye

Sideline of Agenda Requested by Don Howes

- Don would like to Liaison between Parks department and Highway Department
 - o Plan for full time employee for the next fiscal year
 - o Future joint meeting between parks and highway department
 - Discussion over what work has been done on employee share between highway and parks
- MSDV Liaison between parks and highway commission unanimous aye
- Road Commissioner meeting is second Wednesday, Parks meets the Thursday after to post the job
- Meeting next Thursday (28th) to review temporary supervisory position. Rob Jackson will not be in attendance

Phillips Field (Formerly Mellen Field)

- Discussion around moving playground and options
 - o Looking at northeast corner near stockade fence

Action->> Don Howes to walk the lot with Mike Smith and discuss options for a 60'x40' playground.

- New dugouts tamped stone would be the best option for the team
 - o Estimated cost \$1000, can use usage fees
 - o MSDV to permit spending and work unanimous aye
- Sprinkler system being worked by Advantage Irrigation
 - o Suggestion that we remove controls from shed and place an outdoor control unit with

- a lock
- There was some concern over section of the field being very wet, worried about a leak
- o Lacrosse done in about 2 weeks time, which will free up time to work on the field
- o Advantage should be able to come in on Fridays when the field isn't utilized

Action->> Don to check with highway to see what equipment is available to do slice seeding, as well as concrete blocks for parking lot

- Need to look at fixing parking lots with re-grind
 - Big issues in the parking lot with people parking along roadway safety hazard blocking road
 - o Need to walk the field and discuss parking/driveway options
- Mike Smith proposed temporary fencing for the softball fields, along with small opportunities for local sponsorship
 - Concern over zoning Mike volunteered to discuss fencing and signage with the zoning board
 - o MSDV to allow fencing if approved by zoning board unanimous aye

Draper Fields

 Any discussion on hold until commission receives official notification and timeline of field handoff

Tennis Courts

- Sport Court has provided an estimate of \$6000 to patch the courts with acrylic latex and cement, and color to blend
 - o MSDV to fix the tennis courts unanimous aye
 - o Dave Guglielmi will meet with representative from Sport Court and Don Howes
- Lighting fixed with assistance from fire department (11 of 12 lights fixed)

Action->> Secretary to send a letter to Fire Department acknowledging and thanking them for their assistance.

- Don Howes pursuing LED lighting options for the courts with Northern Energy Services
- Commission formally thanked citizen Dave Guglielmi for all of his help with the tennis courts. We are very grateful for his volunteer efforts.

Proposal to investigate new locking system for the parks and facilities

- Re-key everything, employing a locksmith to create some master keys for all, and some that are specific to certain facilities (such as the new key for the flag pole)
- Commission will keep a ledger to track the distribution and collection of keys

Action->> Don Howes to investigate cost and options

Proposal for Peace Picnic in Adin Ballou Park

- Requested for Sunday, August 2nd, from 3 to 5 PM
- MSDV to permit unanimous aye

Alternatives Valley Friendship Tour

- 50 Mile bike tour starts in Whitinsville, includes Hopedale as part of the route
- Request to use portion of parks to place a water stop, riders coming down Dutcher St. from 140 onto Hopedale St
- MSDV to permit unanimous aye

Fin and Feather Summer Plans

- Asking to supply porta-potties at the bath house

Action->> Don Howes to arrange facilities at bath house. All porta-potties should be handicapped accessible

- Summer camp 4 days for each session, Monday through Thursday 9 AM to 2 PM for two sessions, July 13th to the 16th, July 27th to the 30th.
- MSDV to permit unanimous aye

Bathrooms at Town Park

- Work donated by local citizen Kevin McDonald to fix water and faucets in the bathrooms, working on pricing for all non-working items
- Investigating a price on a 3rd toilet for the ladies room
- Looking to create a cabinet for storage within the bathrooms, donated time and materials cost is a padlock

Some park by-laws are not being adhered to

- Metal detectors being used in town park
- Could be an instance of unawareness

Action->> Secretary to create signs to be placed at parks notifying public of laws

Action->> Don Howes to discuss situation with Hopedale Police

Concerns raised over Facebook posting for contractors and volunteers

- Post was not on Parks Commission website
- Concerns over who would be vetting out volunteers quality and safety/security
- Commission agreed that nobody will be doing work without being reviewed and managed by at least one person on the commission.

Adjournment

As the evening was late, Chair Iacovelli motioned to adjourn at 21:15 and meet again the following week. Chair Iacovelli-Aye; Secretary/Treasurer Jackson – Aye
