Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order suspending certain provisions of the open meeting law, GL chapter 30A, section 18, and the Governor's March 15 and August 7, 2020 Orders imposing strict limitations on the number of people that may gather in one place, the regular business meeting of the Hopedale School Committee was conducted via remote participation. The Chair called the meeting to order at 3:03 pm under these provisions with a quorum present. She announced that the meeting was being recorded.

The Chair stated that the Committee would not be reconvening in public session and declared the meeting adjourned at 3:04 pm.
