## **Old Business**

- A. <u>Solar System</u> Kopelman and Paige is working on the RFP for the solar system proposal. All documentation was requested to be completed for a possible fall Town Meeting. Attorney Doneski will be working on this for the Town.
- B. Waste Water Treatment Plant Update Water/Wastewater Manager, Tim Watson and Wastewater Chief Operator Ken Webb met with Engineers from Weston & Sampson. Weston and Sampson informed Tim and Ken that major upgrades would

be needed in order to meet the requirements of the new discharge permit. As requested by the board a complete plant evaluation was performed. Tim informed the board that a number of the suggested upgrades he would like to address within the working budget. Such as doors, windows as well as smaller pump and motor upgrades. It was requested that Weston & Sampson provide a breakdown of priority and cost for each upgrade and that Tim would like to utilize the back portion of the treatment plant in order to prevent excavation and disruption to the existing process during construction.

Out of town septic was also discussed. It is believed that this process is not only affecting the treatment process but also costing more to treat than what the service revenue brings in. By stopping this service, the town may not only save money but comply with permit conditions for a nitrogen removal plan. Chairman Burns asked if we could upgrade the system and have the haulers pay for it through fees. It was explained that the cost to build would be more than the haulers would be willing to pay as there are other places to dump that would be cheaper. The service will continue until the Board hears form Weston & Sampson at their next meeting in October.

C. <u>Mill Street Well Field</u> – the 2 new wells installed in the spring at the Mill Street well-field have been connected by installing 200' of water mains. Flow testing will be conducted on these wells and the well field within the next couple of weeks.
