

364 West St, Hopedale Ma - what's happened to the forestry and wetlands, the Hopedale Watershed

1. Access way: from rt 140 looking into the property

Here's the entry way into the property, from rt 140. (David, this is where you took the photo of Bernie Stock. Suzanne, you also took a few pictures at this spot.) (West St entrance 08 29 2022.jpg)
