Continuation Hearing for Case # 1-2023

The applicant, 75-131 Plain St, LLC is seeking a special permit under the Hopedale Zoning Bylaw, Section 17 Groundwater Protection District, Subsection 17.6(c)(6) for a use that will render impervious more than fifteen percent or 2,500 square feet of any lot at 75 Plain Street.

Scott Savage notified the applicant that with one member absent, all four members would have to vote favorably for the special permit request to pass. Attorney Joe Antonellis requested a short recess to speak with the applicant as not having a full board does create an issue.

Lou Costanza made a motion to allow for a short recess at the request of the applicant, seconded by Sandra Biagetti. All were in favor.
